- Only tree lodge at the Kenyan Coast
- Built next to a water hole
- Owner managed

- 2 Suites
- 3 Triple rooms
- 13 Twin rooms

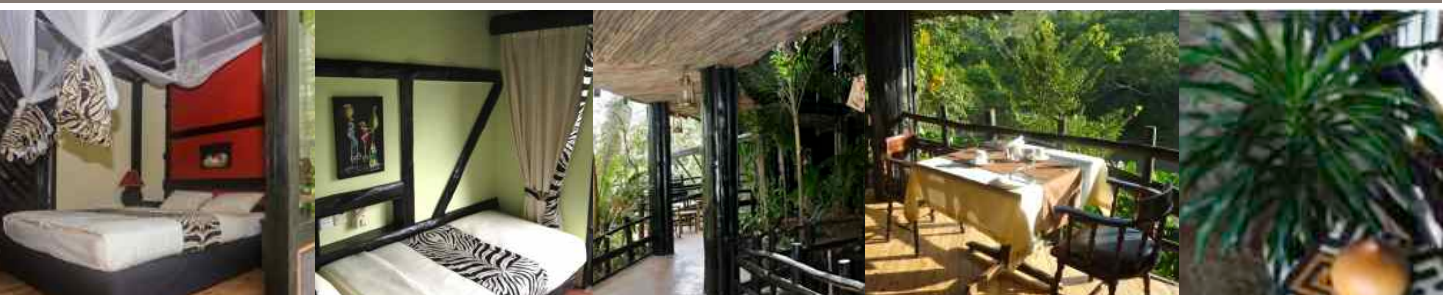
All rooms:

- Small balconies overlooking the waterhole
- Ceiling fans
- Mosquito nets
- Handtowels
- Shower towels
- Bathroom amenities
- Bottled water - 0,5l/person - in the room included in the rate.

The twin and triple rooms share washroom facilities opposite the rooms. The washrooms are spacious (34 SM) and six rooms share two washroom facilities which were renovated in 2015.

Suites

The lodge has two suites, both with a living room, bedroom and en-suite bathroom. The wooden balcony is overlooking the waterhole and can be accessed from both rooms. The suites are equipped with a small fridge, a kettle and tea cups. Bottled drinking water, tea, coffee and sugar are provided and included in the room rate.

The Shimba Lodge is located in the heart of the **Shimba Hills National Reserve** in the Kwale district.

Bush babies will come at dinner time, waiting for their opportunity getting spoiled with a bite.
